- Registration shall not be done if there is no vacancy or likelihood of any vacancy in a particular class in the MMPS.
- Registration forms shall be made available on line on <http://mmpublicschool.org>
- Registration forms complete in all respects and accompanied by all required documents(if present or may be submitted later) must be submitted/sent to MMPS.

ELIGIBLE AGE FOR ADMISSION: Admissions for class NURSERY to IX and XI are being done through online mode & offline.

A Child must be 5 years old as on 31st March in the academic year in which admission is sought for Class I. (Child born on 1st April should also be considered.)

- The minimum age limit for admission in M.M. Public Sr. Sec. School in various classes is given below: **(Child born on 1st April should also be considered.)**

There is no age restriction for admission to Class XI provided the student is seeking admission in the year of passing Class X examination. Similarly, there will be no upper & lower age limit for admission to class XII provided there has been no break in the continuous study of the student after passing class XI.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:

a) **Birth-Certificate:** For Class I, certificate of proof of age in the form of a birth certificate issued by the authority competent to register births. This will include certificates from Notified Area Council / Municipality / Municipal Corporation extract about the date of birth from records of Village Panchayat, Military Hospital and service records of Defence personnel. For other classes, the date of birth recorded in the transfer certificate issued by a school recognized by the State Education Department would be accepted. The original certificate of date of birth should be returned to the parent after verification. Admissions up to class-VIII may be granted without any school transfer certificate provided the child is otherwise eligible and his birth certificate has been issued by a Govt. body.

b) **Transfer-Certificate:** In case of need, **Original T.C. required issued by the previous school.**

c) **Character-Certificate:** For class XI.

d) **Mark-Sheet:** Needs as per concerned class passed from previous school.

e) **Caste-Certificate:(In case of SC/ST/OBC/EWS etc.)**

- A certificate that the child belongs to the Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/EWS/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/BPL wherever applicable, issued by the competent authority in concerned State Government/Union Government. The certificate in respect of either of the parents may be accepted initially, for the purpose of admission, if this certificate is not available for the child. However, the certificate in respect of the child has to be submitted within a period of 03 months from the date of admission.

c) **Handicap-Certificate: (In case Physically disabled)**

- A certificate from the civil surgeon/rehabilitation centre or any other competent authority defined by the Government of India O.M. No. 36035/5/88/Estt. (sct) dated 4.5.1999 certifying the child to be handicapped, wherever applicable. In case, where the handicap of the child can be visually seen by the Principal, the child may be accepted as handicapped even without a certificate. However, the parent may be advised to obtain the relevant certificate from the competent authority and submit the same to the school.

- Proof of Residence

Note :

- Mere registration will not confer a right to admission.

- Incomplete application forms shall normally be rejected. In case vacancies remain, Principal of MMPS may allow completion of the form later at his discretion.
- Admission secured on the basis of any wrong certificate shall be cancelled by the Principal of MMPS forthwith and no appeal against such action of the Principal shall be entertained.

NOTE: In case non-availability of above documents, an undertaking has to be given for the same.

FEE AND OTHER CONCESSIONS:

- No fee to be charged from the children admitted under the 25% quota prescribed under RTE Act 2009
- Expenses on account of NCERT text book, note books, stationary, uniform and transport will be reimbursed on production of proper bills in respect of 25% of the children admitted under the RTE Provisions subject to the ceiling prescribed and availability of funds.
- Once the children are admitted in Class I under RTE Act, they will continue to enjoy exemptions and concessions till class VIII.
- Address proof of the parent should be furnished at the time of the registration.
- The employees who have the facility of fee reimbursement in their departments cannot claim RTE concessions.

- FOR REBATES IN SCHOOL FEES FROM ACADEMIC SESSION 2020-2021:
 1. In case of two children of the same parents:
 - 1st Child's Full Fee and 2nd Child's 25% rebate in Composite Annual Fee only.
 2. In case of three children of the same parents:

- 1st and 2nd Child's Full Fee, 3rd Child's 50% rebate in Composite Annual Fee only.
- 3. In case of four children of the same parents:
- 1st, 2nd and 3rd Child's Full Fee, 4th Child's 100% rebate in Composite Annual Fee only.
- **MODE OF PAYMENT :**
- 1st Instalment : April/May/June pay by 15 of April.
- 2nd Instalment : July/August+HYE-FEE pay by 15 of July.
- 3rd Instalment : September/October pay by 15 of September.
- 4th Instalment : November/December+AE-FEE pay by 15 of December.
- 5th Instalment : January/February/March pay by 15 of January.
- Note: 1. After the pay by date LATE-PAYMENT fine will be charged Rs 10.00 with Rs 2.00 per day till the fee is deposited.
- 2. During the Pandemic Corona Virus(COVID-19) period, the rules framing by the government will be considered in case of parents/guardians need to seek the relaxation.
- **METHOD OF ADMISSION IN CLASS NURSERY TO IX & XI**
 - Admission test shall not be conducted for admission to Class NURSERY to IX & XI and the admission may be granted based on Priority category system.

METHOD OF ADMISSION IN CLASS IX:

> For admission to Class IX, an admission test shall be conducted and a merit list will be prepared for each category of priority separately. Admission shall be granted in the sequence of priority categories, in the order of merit

- Admission test shall be conducted in the subjects: Hindi, English, Maths and Science.
- There will be only one paper of Admission test of 1 Hours duration & 100 marks comprising Hindi, English, Maths & Science each of 25 marks.
- Candidates must secure 33% marks in aggregate to qualify. Students belonging to SC/ST/Divyang category (PH) will be eligible for admission on securing 25% in aggregate.

METHOD OF ADMISSIONS IN CLASS XI

MMPS Students: Admission in different streams viz Science & Commerce of Class XI will be based on aggregate marks scored in class X exams as under:

- Science Stream: A minimum of 60% Marks in aggregate of all subjects.
- Commerce: A minimum of 50% Marks in aggregate of all subjects.

Other Schools' Students: Admission in different streams viz Science & Commerce of Class XI in MMPS will be based on Marks scored in class X exams as under:

- Science Stream: A minimum of 60% Marks in aggregate of all subjects.
- Commerce: A minimum of 50% Marks in aggregate of all subjects.

Note:- If seats remain vacant in class XI even after admitting the children of MMPS then the admissions to non MMPS children may be granted on the same criteria, in the sequence of categories of priority.

Concessions wherever applicable shall be incorporated while preparing the Merit List.
